Artwork submitted can be a visual rendition including, but not limited to:

A painting, drawing, sculpture, mosaic, or photograph

A work of calligraphy

A work of graphic art including, but not limited to, an etching, lithograph, serigraph, or offset print

A craft work in materials including but not limited to clay, textiles, fiber, wood, metal, plastic, or glass

A work in mixed media including but not limited to, a collage or assemblage of work consisting of any combination of the above media

All artwork considered must be original work. No kits or copies of original art work. If work was taken from an original then copyright must be resolved by the submitting artisan/craftsman/ with credit given to the creator of the original piece that the modified work was taken from.

Samples of artwork or specific art work on disk, website or in photographs must be presented along with application.

Chosen artisan/craftsman will sign a legal and binding contract with the Champaign County Forest Preserve District, Early American Museum Gift Shop defining mutually agreed upon prices and time frames. Artisans/craftsman will be expected to read and comply with said contract.

The Early American Museum Gift Shop will not be held liable for loss or damage to the work of art if artisan/craftsman fail to remove the work within 30 days beyond the pickup agreement date.
