The Champaign County Forest Preserve District Board of Commissioners met at a Study Session, Thursday, December 20, 2018 at the Education Classroom, Museum of the Grand Prairie, Lake of the Woods Forest Preserve, Mahomet, Illinois. Commissioner Livesay called the Study Session to order at 5:57 p.m. Commissioner Herakovich called the roll. 

He highlighted current General Assembly regulations on tax caps and ballot language, confirmed the time frames on implementation for successful measures, and stressed the importance of full, accurate communication with the public about District financial needs. Commissioners asked which of the questions was most successful. Phillips noted that voters tend to be more receptive to ballot questions containing identifiable capital proposals.
